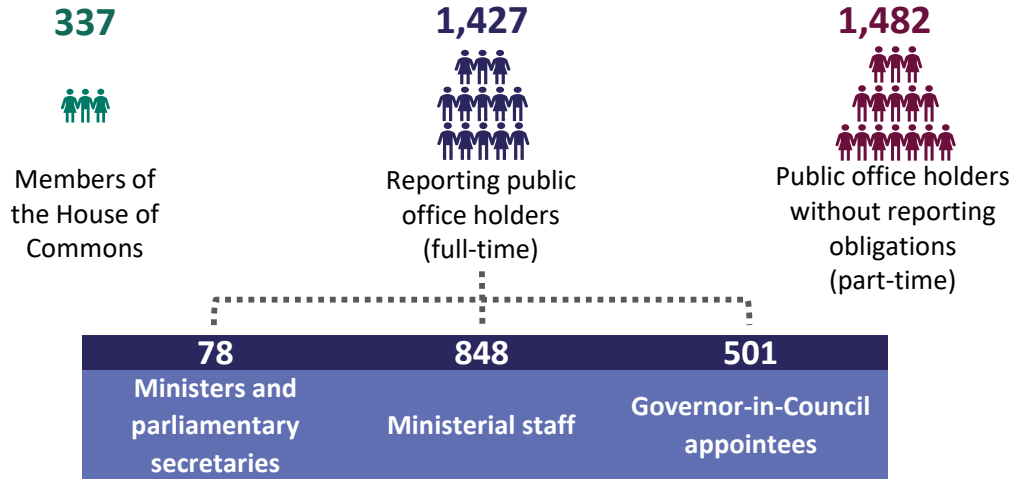

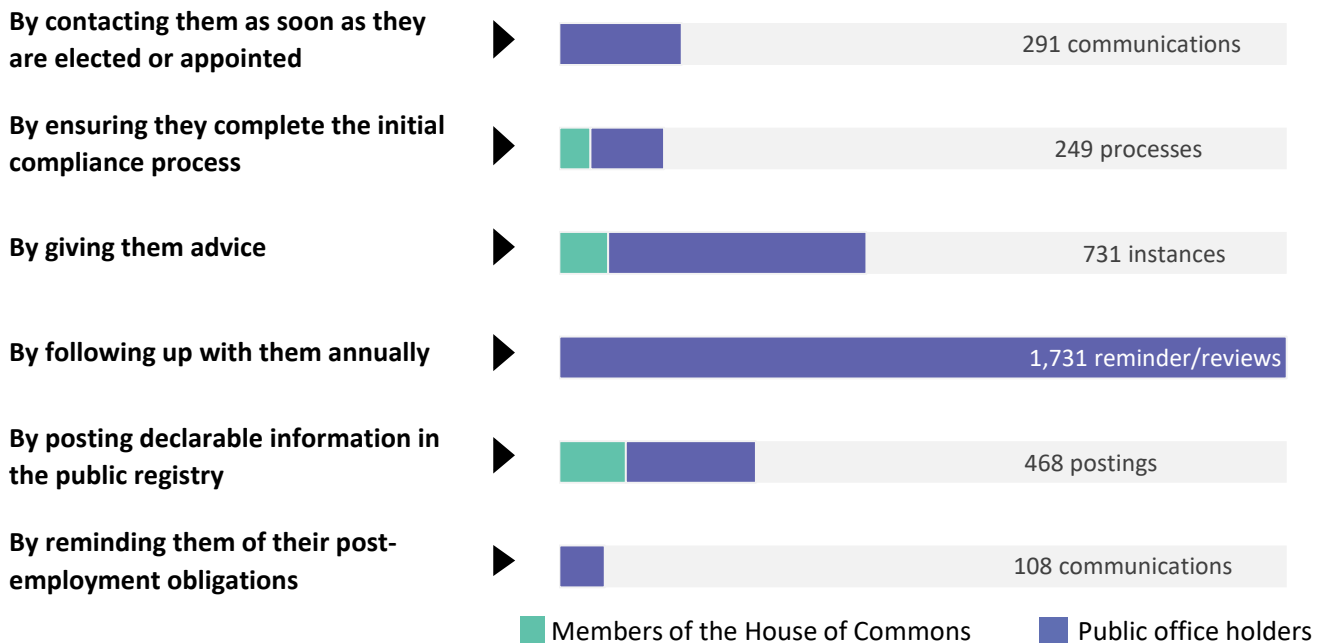
### WHO IS SUBJECT TO THE REGIMES ADMINISTERED BY THE OFFICE?

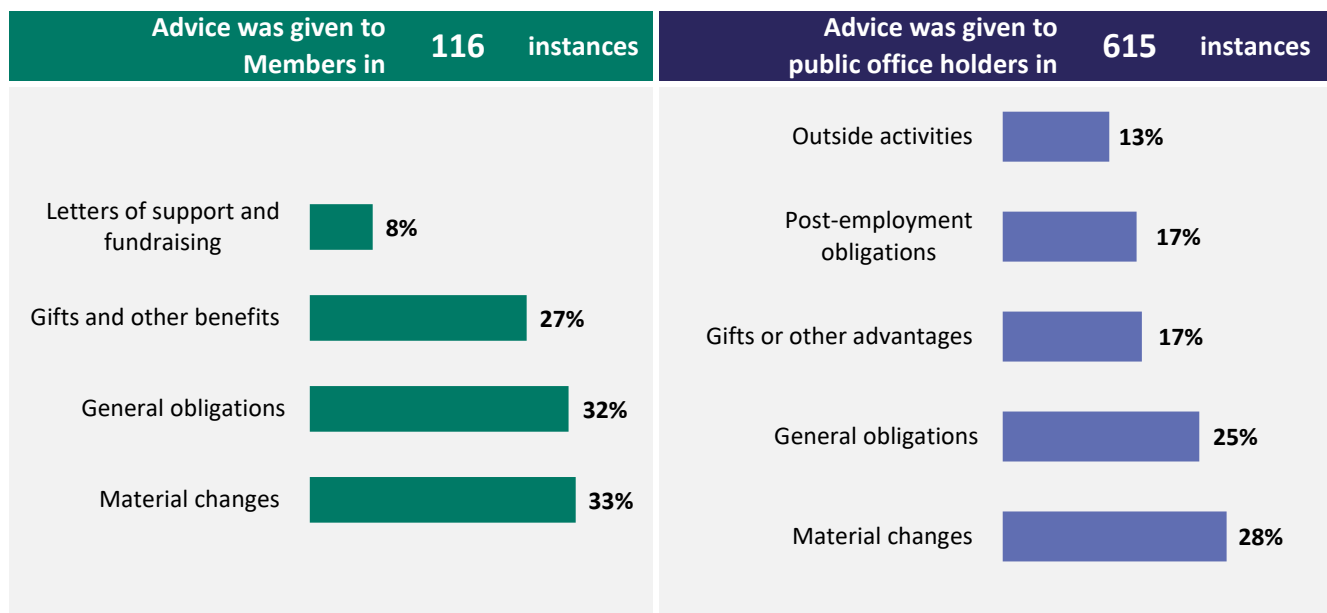

### POST-EMPLOYMENT RULES (*Conflict of Interest Act* only)

Public office holders are subject to post-employment rules after they leave public office.

Additional rules apply to former reporting public office holders for one or two years after they leave office (cooling-off period)

former public office holders still subject to additional rules

Upon request, the Commissioner may grant an exemption, waiver or reduction regarding the duration of the cooling-off period

<p><b>82%</b></p> <p>Percentage of newly appointed reporting public office holders who met all filing deadlines</p>	<p> When a reporting public office holder does not meet a reporting requirement, they are sent a Notice of Violation and given <b>30 days</b> to either pay the administrative monetary penalty or make written representations to the Commissioner.</p> <p><b>5</b> notices of violation sent to public office holders</p>	<p><b>0</b> failures to report all relevant information as part of the Confidential Report</p> <p><b>2</b> failures to report a material change</p> <p><b>0</b> failures to sign a Summary Statement within 120 days of appointment</p> <p> All administrative monetary penalties are tweeted and can be found on our public registry.</p>
