


## WHO IS SUBJECT TO THE REGIMES ADMINISTERED BY THE OFFICE?



# POST-EMPLOYMENT RULES (Conflict of Interest Act only)

Public office holders are subject to post-employment rules after they leave public office.



196

public office holders left office this quarter

Additional rules apply to former reporting public office holders for one or two years after they leave office (cooling-off period)

317

former public office holders still subject to additional rules

Upon request, the Commissioner may grant an exemption, waiver or reduction regarding the duration of the cooling-off period

post-employmentexemptions, waivers or reductions granted

- failures to report all relevant information as part of the **Confidential Report**
- failures to report a material change
- failures to sign a Summary Statement within 120 days of appointment


- 11 ministers or parliamentary secretaries
