


### POST-EMPLOYMENT RULES (Conflict of Interest Act only)

Public office holders are subject to post-employment rules after they leave public office.



public office holders left office this quarter

Additional rules apply to former reporting public office holders for one or two years after they leave office (cooling-off period)

Upon request, the Commissioner may grant an exemption, waiver or reduction regarding the duration of the cooling-off period

former public office 325 holders still subject to additional rules

post-employment exemptions, waivers or 8 reductions granted

When a reporting public office holder does not meet a reporting requirement, they are sent a Notice of Violation and given

### 30 days

to either pay the administrative monetary penalty or make written representations to the Commissioner.

notices of violation sent to public office holders

- failures to report all relevant information as part of the Confidential Report
- failures to report a material change
- failures to sign a Summary

  Statement within 120 days of appointment


